

COVID-19 VACCINE SCHEDULE FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE MODERATELY OR SEVERELY IMMUNOCOMPROMISED

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), people are moderately or severely immunocompromised if they have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or blood cancers
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell/bone marrow transplant in the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- A genetic syndrome that affects the immune system (such as DiGeorge syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress immune response

The CDC recommends the following vaccine schedules:
